Situated in the beautiful Usk Valley, the course has been built to provide a superlative challenge to the world's best golfers and the extensive use of water features presents players with classic match play dilemmas.

Our courses are complemented by two luxurious clubhouses offering award-winning restaurants and numerous private function suites accommodating groups large and small, offering complete flexibility for your society golf day.

In addition, a state of the art Golf Academy, recognised as a National Centre of Excellence for Wales, allows societies to add a golf clinic or individual lessons to complete their day.

THE ROMAN ROAD

Designed by Robert Trent Jones Snr, this challenging par 70 course varies from long open fairways and dramatic descents on the front nine, to a back nine that twists and turns through trees and across lakes and streams.

Roman Road hosted The Celtic Manor Wales Open, a leading European Tour event, from 2005 to 2007, the 2006 Junior Ryder Cup and the celebrity-packed All*Star Cup.

THE MONTGOMERIE

In July 2007, the Resort unveiled a challenging new par 69 course designed by the Ryder Cup legend, Colin Montgomerie.

His first design project to open in Britain, The Montgomerie at Celtic Manor reflects the champion golfer's roots in traditional links golf. Spectacular views abound with breathtaking shots over valleys, while inviting downhill shots provide an exciting and rewarding challenge.

Society golf days can be booked a maximum of 6 months in advance on The Twenty Ten and Roman Road, and up to 12 months in advance on The Montgomerie.

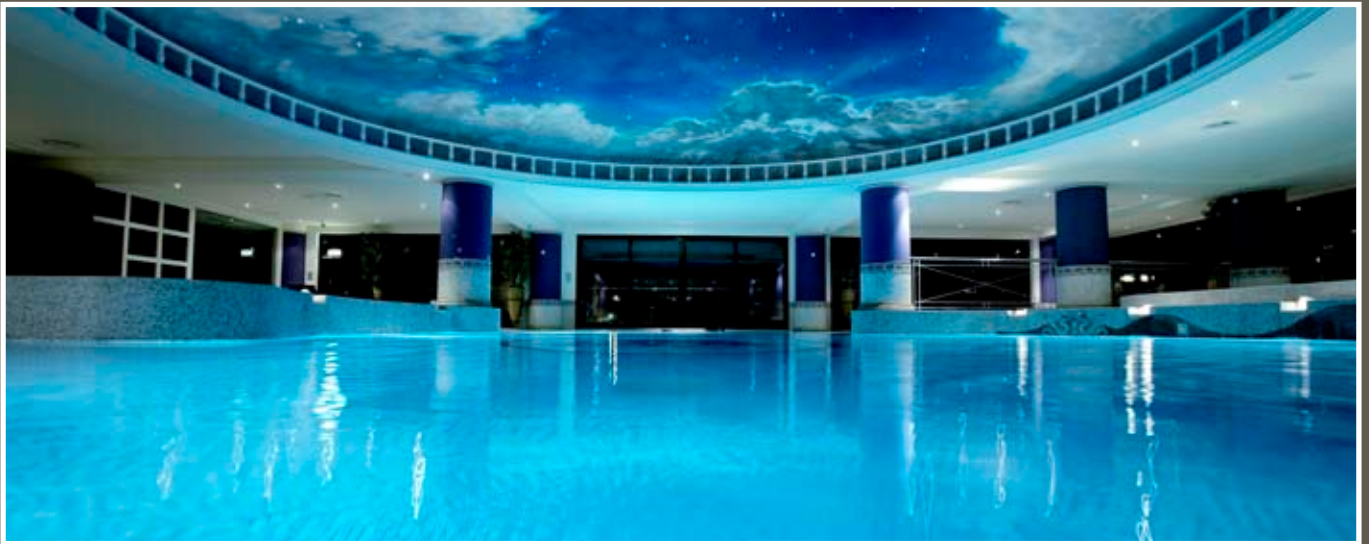


WHY NOT STAY OVER?
