2. GETTING HERE & PARKING

For all Private Pod, Gazebo and General Admission ticket holders:

Leave the M4 at junction 24 and take the B4237 towards Newport. Yellow AA event signage will direct you past the main entrance to The Celtic Manor Resort and onwards to the village of Caerleon. Please continue to follow this signage which will lead you to the Motoring car park located adjacent to the Motoring Arena, just off the Caerleon to Usk road. Please note that there is no access to the event via the Resort Hotel, therefore, you should arrange suitable return transport for your departure after the event from the Motoring car park.

If you have a prestige or classic car and would like it displayed in an exclusive viewing area please visit the website to book a place. There are limited spaces available for these displays. Additional £10 charge applies.

3. DRESS CODE

Motoring at the Manor is also an outdoor event, therefore we would remind you to please dress appropriately for the weather conditions on the day. Please remember your sun cream, sunglasses and a hat if the weather is hot. Alternatively, with the changeable nature of the Great British Summer, a waterproof jacket, umbrella and pair of flat shoes are always a great thing to have with you, just in case!

4. FOOD & DRINK

We will have a selection of food and drink alfresco outlets to purchase items from on the day.

Guests also have the option of pre-ordering one of our gourmet **Motoring Picnic Hampers***, which can be collected on the day. Please visit celtic-manor.com for more details and to view the picnic menu (advance booking essential). *Please note the Hamper is not served in a wicker basket.

Spectators are not permitted to bring any food or drinks into the Motoring at the Manor event site, any found will be confiscated and destroyed.

To reduce our environmental impact, all outlets will serve drinks in re-usable Ecocup. An additional charge will be applied on the purchase of your first drink, however these cups can be exchanged at the bar for subsequent drinks purchased. We encourage you to keep re-using this cup throughout the event and you are welcome to take it home as a souvenir at the end of the day. All cups will have bespoke Celtic Manor event designs.

5. WEATHER CONDITIONS

Motoring at the Manor is an outdoor event and will go ahead regardless of the weather conditions on the day. The event will not be cancelled unless the conditions pose a risk to our exhibitors, demonstration drivers or the public.

6. ACCESSIBILITY

We aim to make Motoring at the Manor accessible to all regardless of disability, however, please be aware that due to the situation of this outdoor event site there is a relatively long walk from the car park to the Motoring Arena which may present difficulties for people with limited mobility.

Please note that disabled toilet facilities will be available within the Motoring Village on the day.

7. SPECTATOR SAFETY
