CLIENT NAME: SOCIETY FOR RESEARCH INTO HIGHER EDUCATION

Type of Event:

Four-day annual research conference with Gala Dinner. This is the fourth year that SRHE have held this particular event at the Celtic Manor Resort. Delegates were a mix of students and educators.

Number of delegates:

Delegate numbers varied from day to day but the conference peaked at 350 attendees.

Number of bedrooms /nights for delegates:

8th December — 8 x beds
9th December — 122 x beds
10th December — 318 x beds
11th December — 306 x beds
12th December — 8 x beds
Total - 762 room nights

Number of staff working on event:

Approximately 180 staff in total

NUMBER OF MEETINGS HELD & MEETING ROOMS USED

10th, 11th & 12th December — Main meeting in the Caernarfon Suite all day with 12 x syndicate rooms each day for breakout meetings and 3 x offices located on Level C2 in the Convention Centre 9th December — Smaller meeting (Newer Researchers Conference) for 87 delegates in Beaumaris Suite

GALA DINNER DETAILS

Gala Dinner for 350 people in the Caernarfon Suite with a small Awards Presentation followed by a disco to close the evening.

OTHER FOOD/BEVERAGE REQUIREMENTS

Bowl food dinner for 30 x guests in Merlins (9th Dec)
Dine around dinner in Olive Tree, Le Patio, Rafters & The Grill restaurants (10th Dec)
In total, 762 Breakfasts, 1052 Lunches, 754 Dinners.

TRANSPORT LOGISTICS

Transport required on Tuesday 9th December for 55 x guests from neighbouring hotel to the Celtic Manor Resort

EVENT PLANNING

Event manager received the file in April 2014 and went to London to meet with the client to discuss their requirements for the event. Remained in regular contact with client in the lead up to the event and had regular planning meetings. On Monday 8th December a pre-conference meeting took place with the client, Event Manager and the operational managers at the resort.

LEGACY FOR FUTURE EVENTS

SRHE are definitely returning to the Resort in 2015 and 2016 and will hopefully return for many years to come. 2015 is their 50th Anniversary Year.
